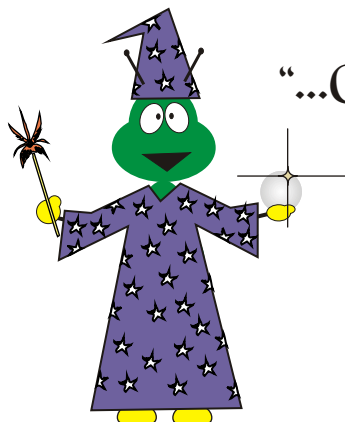
## Literary Guest of Honor: Lyda Morehouse
