Our 2005 Artist Guest of Honor: Todd Coss

Todd Coss grew up in Georgia and has been drawing "ever since I can remember—no, really." He developed his drawing skills during high school, and enlisted in the Navy, serving during Operation Desert Storm as a photographer. Many of Todd's slide images can be found in the National Archives in Washington, D.C. He attended the Art Institute of Atlanta majoring in illustration and computer animation. Among his comic influences are Don Wetzel, Dave Stevens, Steve Rude, and John Byrne. Recently Todd and his collaborators at Studio Creations won Best Animation in the Star Wars Fan Film competition for the parody "Trooper Clerks". Todd is also an active



costumer, constructing such outfits as Darth Maul, D'argo, Londo Mollari, Harvey Birdman, and The Fifth Element's Mangalores. Todd's current projects include interior art for role-playing books for Imagine Games and Hero Games and developing an original graphic novel series. Todd just recently moved to the Twin Cities and "fell into our laps" when he volunteered to contribute artwork for our badges, publications and T-shirt. We were all so impressed by his amazing diverse talent and flamboyant comic-book style that we had to invite him to be our Artist Guest of Honor.



OUR FEATURED GUEST ARTIST: RON ROSS

Ron Ross was born March 11, 1935 in Mitchell, South Dakota. He graduated from Mitchell High School in 1953 and from Dakota Wesleyan University in 1957 with a Bachelor of Arts degree and a minor in radio, speech, and drama. MarsCon is honoring Ron this year as a local Twin Cities teacher and artist who has worked for 50 years as a free-lance cartoonist. During his long and distinguished career, he has drawn over 5,000 cartoons and seen them published in a wide-ranging list of prominent national magazines and

journals, including National Enquirer, Saturday Evening Post, and Harvard Business Review, among several others. While his focus hasn't usually been in the science-fiction/fantasy genre, he has done several fun and whimsical pieces that are sure to entertain our fans.

Todd and Ron will be doing a panel together on cartooning and caricature art. Todd will be showing his award winning fan flick "Trooper Clerks". They both will be at our Artist's Reception, and will show their artwork in our Art Show.
